Parents ~ Learn What It Is and What You Can Do to Prevent It

Results of the 2010 Emerson Hospital Youth Risk Behavior Survey:

- 27% of grade 6 students reported having been bullied in school in the past 12 months
- 22% for grade 8
- 11% of grade 6 students reported experiencing cyber-bullying in the past 12 months
- 20% for grade 8
